

Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA)

People wishing to work in a bar, Club, cafe, restaurant or venue that is licensed to sell alcohol within Victoria, will need a Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificate, accredited by the Victorian Commission for Liquor and Gambling Regulation (VCGLR). MDLC are a VCGLR approved provider for the 4 hour Responsible Service of Alcohol Course.



English Language Classes

Mountain District Learning Centre delivers daytime English Language programs at both Boronia library and Ferntree Gully. This program is for people from non-English speaking backgrounds.

The Certificate in Spoken & Written English program provides learning in listening, speaking, reading and writing as well as help with grammar and pronunciation.
