


# STUDY AT A PLACE **THAT'S RIGHT FOR YOU**

**INFORMATION ABOUT FEES** 

Learn Local courses are generously

subsidised by the Victoria State Government.

You must be an Australian citizen or hold

permanent residency to receive reduced

fees. If you're not eligible you can still enrol

in the class, but you will pay a higher fee. You

will be asked for proof of eligibility when you

enrol. Concession fees are also available if

you are an eligible pensioner or concession

card holder. The reduced fee includes \$30

tuition, \$10 amenities and \$10 materials

(unless otherwise stated) and manuals

where applicable.

Swinlocal is a partnership between the KLA and Swinburne University VET to provide pathways courses into TAFE qualifications. All Swinlocal courses include some training onsite at TAFE.
